A pro-choice rally is taking place in Dublin city this afternoon.

Campaigners who have been travelling around Ireland on the Abortion Pill Bus will hold a demonstration outside the central bank from 3.30.

The bus previously stopped in the cities of Galway, Limerick and Cork yesterday and today, before it made its way back to Dublin.

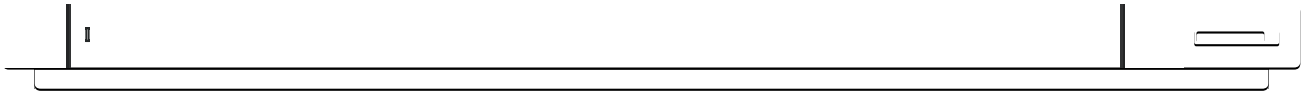


Groups campaigning for the 8th Amendment to be removed from our constitution will be taking part in today's rally.

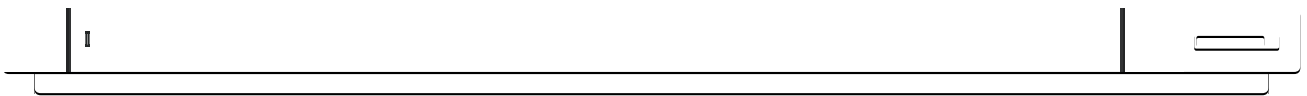
The 8th Amendment gives equal right to life to the unborn as that of the mother.

Deputy Coppinger explains who contacted the campaigners on the bus to avail of an abortion pill consultation:

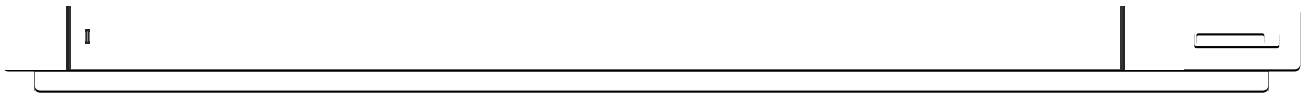


Ailbhe Smyth from the Repeal the 8th Coalition says abortion pills are available online and require some medical supervision:

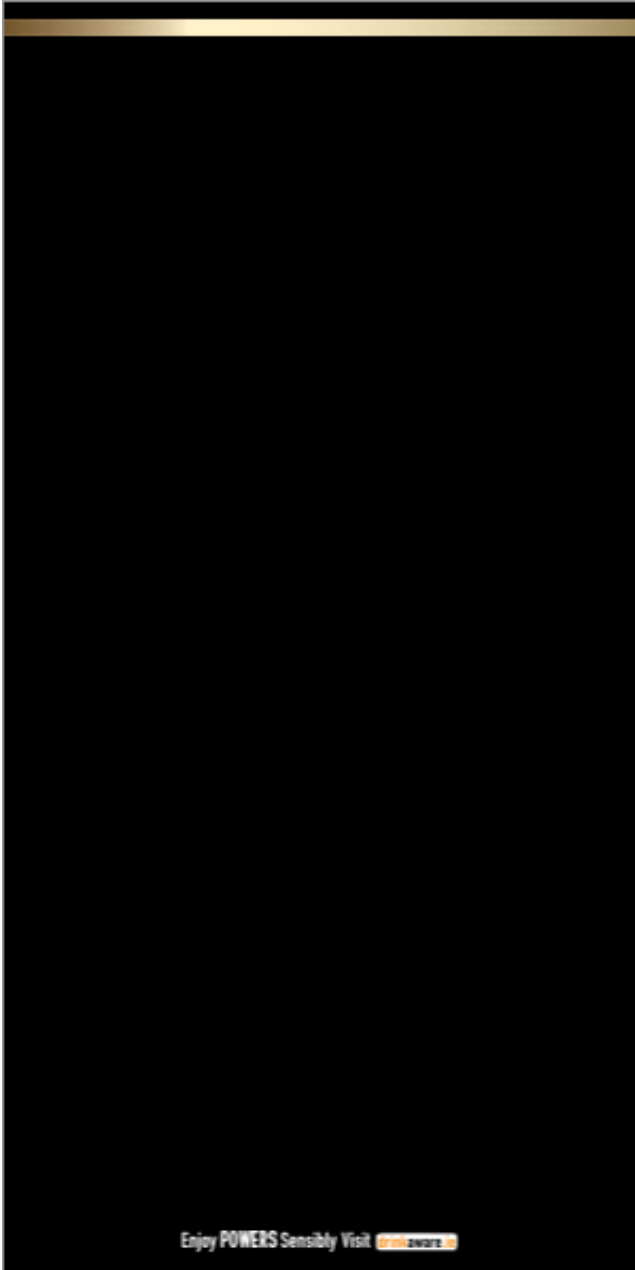

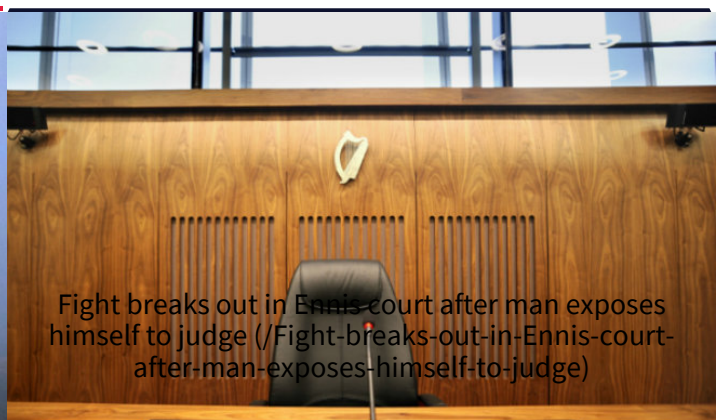
